Do you want to **Teach English** in your home country?

This is a great option if you're a non-native speaker of English who wants to learn effective English language teaching methods and practice, and prepare for the internationally recognised Cambridge Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT).

What do I get with Crown's TESOL courses?

- There are two courses of four weeks each. They prepare students for the Cambridge Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT).

The first four-week course prepares you for Module 1 of the Cambridge TKT, and the second four-week course prepares you for Modules 2 and 3 of the Cambridge TKT. You should complete Course 1 before starting Course 2.

Note that the courses are NZQA approved.

- The courses include: language skill development, lesson observations, language awareness, class management, background to language learning, materials and task evaluations, language teaching methodologies, teaching, planning and practice evaluations.
- Students prepare for TKT, compare differing teaching methodologies, gain ideas for class teaching, get lots of teaching practice and receive a Crown certificate of achievement on completion.

How do I apply for the TESOL course at Crown?

- Ask your study abroad agent about TESOL at Crown.
- Entry to the Crown TESOL course is open to international students who are 18 years and over who have an English level of at least IELTS 5.0 or accepted equivalent. Candidates will also have to pass an interview with a Crown-staff member.
- Complete the enrolment form and specify TESOL at Crown.
- Pay the fees to your agent and if necessary, arrange your visa.
