

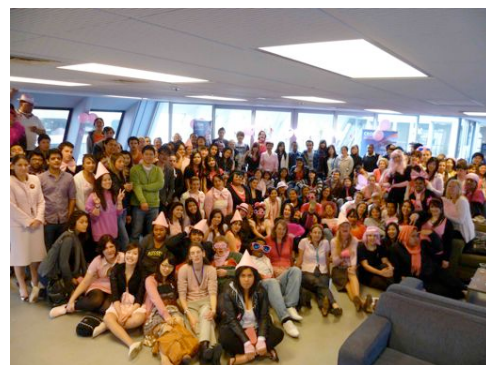

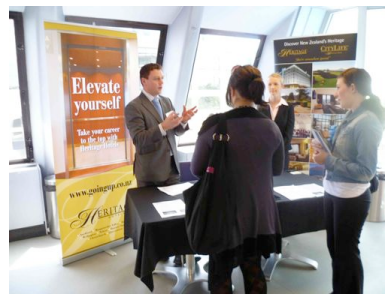
## Students Work at Fashion Week & Melbourne Cup
