You can complete the NZDipBus in just 56 weeks at Crown!

Students who complete the New Zealand Diploma in Business with a B grade average will gain entry to The University of Auckland with up to 90 points of credit towards the BBIM, BCom or BProp degree

Students who complete all papers in Phases A and D are eligible for the New Zealand Institute of Management Diploma in Management Level 5 qualification.

International students are then eligible for the one year Graduate Open Work Visa after just 28 weeks of study!
